

## 1:1 Learning

Note to sixth graders and families new to the middle school; Our Lady's Middle School is a 1:1 learning environment. Families of OLA students in sixth grade and above are required to provide their students with a laptop computer for daily use at school. Much of our curriculum is computer-based and requires a relatively recent laptop to access materials and complete classwork. Chromebook computers are acceptable and are often less expensive than Apple or Windows computers. We highly recommend an updated chromebook. We have found students using older operations systems have difficulty accessing some of the platforms we use. An iPad will not be adequate.

- (1) Hand Soap
