REQUIREMENT FOR NEW VOLUNTEERS AND STAFF

As per the Archdiocese of Boston, all employees and volunteers of Our Lady's Academy over the age of 18 who have contact with children must complete Protecting God's Children (PGC) training. The training session provides education on how to recognize indicators of possible abuse or grooming, how to create safe environments for youth, and how to report your concerns. The training is an in person, 2.5 hour session. You are only required to take this training once, and will receive a certificate at the end. Please note that if you are NOT able to attend our session, you must find another session at a church within the Archdiocese of Boston, and complete that session within one month of our date in order to volunteer or work with children. Sessions are held at churches throughout the year.
